



Hook, Line & Dinner FAQ

Q: What does my general admission ticket include?

A: General admission includes a delicious seafood dinner and plenty of beer (while supplies last), and an intimate-setting concert.

Q: What does the VIP ticket include?

A: VIP tickets also includes early admission, welcome toast, priority seating, and swag bag.

Q: What does a VIP table include?

A: VIP table includes eight (8) VIP tickets and recognition on the event website, table signage, and recognition in event program.

Q: What other festivities will take place?

A: In addition to dinner and concert, guests can partake in our silent auction, a game of heads-and-tales for a prize, fun photo opportunity, and yard games (weather permitting).

Q: Can I buy just a concert ticket?

A: No, concert tickets are not sold separately.

Q: Can I purchase tickets day of?

A: Tickets will only be available if the event does not sell out prior to event day.

Q: Can I purchase tickets directly through MCFA?

A: Yes, avoid online service fees by purchasing tickets directly through MCFA. Complete [THIS FORM](#) or contact us at 207-956-0752 to make payments.

Q: What age groups are appropriate?

A: This event does not have age restrictions but may not be suitable for young children.

Q: Are there children or family ticket prices?

A: No.

Q: What type of dinner will be served?

A: Dinner will include a delicious array of seafood. Because the seafood is donated by our fishermen we cannot announce the menu until closer to the event. Last years event included lobster, clams, scallop cakes, seafood chowder, salad, and dessert.

Q: Will you have options other than seafood?

A: Our event will not have alternative dinner options, but guests are welcome to purchase your own food from Cook's.

Q: What is the event attire?

A: From oilskins and stinky boats to cocktail attire, there is no dress code. However, shirt and shoes are required.

Q: Where can I park?

A: Parking at Cook's is limited and carpooling is recommended. MCFA will provide a shuttle from an off-site parking lot. *Stay tuned for more information.*

Q: What happens if it rains?

A: The event is held rain or shine. The majority of event activities will be held under a tent.

Q: Can I bring and tie-up my boat?

A: Space for boat tie-up is limited and will be handled on a case-by-case basis. Please contact Monique Coombs at Monique@mainecoastfishermen.org to make arrangements.

A: All proceeds benefit the Maine Coast Fishermen's Association and our work to build a better and brighter future with diverse fishing businesses, robust fish stocks, and vibrant working coastal communities.

A: MCFA is a 501(c)3 tax-exempt nonprofit organization and donations are tax deductible. Our tax ID number is 13-4337702. Event tickets are not tax-deductible.
